### \$500 SCHOLARSHIP Deadline May 1, 2009

A **\$500 scholarship** will be presented to a Clarkston High School senior meeting the following criteria:

- *Has made a commitment to continue his/her higher education upon completion of high school graduation.*
- *Has participated in community service and/or has participated in extracurricular school activities.*
- *Attends Clarkston High School in the Clarkston School District.*

To qualify, the applicant must be a full-time student, meeting graduation requirements (verified by the Clarkston High School contact person).

The candidate shall complete the scholarship application and write an essay. The essay will be written on one of the following topics, "**How I overcame obstacles to reach my goal of higher education.**" Or "**Why I am drug and alcohol free.**" The essay must be double-spaced, 12-point font, typed, and no less than one page. Entry **must** be the original work of the student. Rules of English grammar and composition are expected.

In addition to the essay, the candidate must obtain **two** letters of recommendation: one non-related adult **and** one non-related peer.

The Clarkston Coalition for Youth Scholarship Committee will choose the award recipient.

The Clarkston Coalition for Youth Coalition Scholarship will be presented at the Clarkston High School Senior Awards Night. A member of the Clarkston Coalition for Youth Coalition or their designee will present it.

The recipient of the scholarship shall contact the Clarkston Coalition for Youth within six weeks of notification of the award to make arrangements to receive the scholarship. The \$500 scholarship will be paid by check to the institution upon the recipient's proof of registration or enrollment in a post high school educational/vocational training program.

The recipient must meet **all** of the above requirements.
